



Did you know... About your Animache horse and Shetland pony?

How many hands are in a horse?

A **horse's** height is measured in hands, with a hand measuring 4 inches. At birth, a horse's legs are almost as long as when it is fully grown! Which helps the foal (baby horse) to walk within 1-2 hours of birth, and from there a horse learns to trot, canter and gallop.

What's named after Scottish islands and strong?

The **Shetland Pony** is named after a group of islands off the North coast of Scotland and whilst small, is able to pull twice its own weight! A bright eyed, bushy tailed creature indeed...
